




Access to courts during COVID-19 | 11 African Countries | 2020

This is **a snapshot indication** of the performance of a selection of African countries on the provision or facilitation of the right of access to courts during the first month of the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic (20 March -20 April 2020) in Africa.

This snapshot ranks **11 African countries** on physical access to courtrooms, the nature of courts that were open, the nature of legal cases entertained, and the existence of rules for conducting virtual hearings.

The ranking is based on data obtained primarily through desktop research and key informant interviews.

The scorecards provide a snapshot and not a complete picture.


