RESOLUTION ON AFRICAN CANDIDATURES IN THE COMMITTEES AND ORGANS OF THE UNITED NATIONS

The Council of Ministers of the organization of African Unity meeting in its Thirtythird Ordinary Session in Monrovia, Liberia, from 6 to 20 July 1979;

Having examined the report of the Secretary-General on African Candidatures in the Committee and Organs of the United Nations, Doc. CM/979 (XXXIII);

<u>Considering</u> the criteria used by the African Group in presenting African candidatures in the Committees and Organs of the United Nations contained in Resolution CM/Res. 691 (XXXII) adopted by the Council of Ministers at its 32nd Ordinary Session held in Nairobi, Kenya;

- 1. **ENDORSES** the proposals made by the African Group in New York as contained in document CM/979 (XXXIII);
- 2. **CALLS UPON** all Member States to scrupulously respect these criteria to ensure an equitable representation of the Continent in all United Nations Organs.
