TRAVELLING EXPENSES OF MEMBERS OF THE SCIENTIFIC COUNCIL OF AFRICA

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity, meeting in its Ninth Ordinary Session in Kinshasa, Congo, from 4 to 10 September 1967,

<u>Having</u> discussed the proposal to set up a Central Fund for the travelling of CSA members;

<u>Having</u> noted with deep concern the poor attendance at the last CSA meetings held in Addis Ababa from 8 to 12 April, 1967;

<u>Recalling</u> that the CCTA/CSA had no such difficulties in convening similar meetings as the Organization met full costs of the participating members;

<u>Determined</u> to give continued support to inter-African co-operation in this field as provided for the OAU Charter; and,

<u>Recalling</u> the importance of the work of the CSA in Africa:

- **1.** ACCEPTS in principle the proposal to set up a Central Fund for the travelling expenses of CSA members;
- 2. INVITES the Administrative Secretary-General to study the financial implications of this new proposal and to report to the next meeting of the Council of Ministers.
