RESOLUTION ON THE ACP/EEC LOME CONVENTION (LOME II): DOC. CM/1030 (XXXIV)

The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity, meeting in its Thirty-fourth Ordinary Session in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, from 6 to 15 February 1980,

<u>Having heard</u> the excellent introductory remarks by the representative of the Chairman of the OAU Group in Brussels, Belgium, on the ACP/EEC Lome Convention (Lome II): Doc. CM/1030 (XXXIV),

Recalling Resolution CM/Res. 747 (XXXIII) Rev.1 on the renegotiation of the ACP/EEC Lome Convention,

<u>Recalling further</u> Resolutions 656 (XXXI) and CM/Res. 746 (XXXIII) Rev.1 relating to the OAU Group in Brussels:

- TAKES NOTE, with appreciation, of the report presented by the Chairman of the OAU Group in Brussels;
- 2. COMMENDS the Head of State of the Republic of Togo, General Gnassingbe, the OAU Group in Brussels and the Secretary-General of the Organization of African Unity for their significant contributions to the successful conclusion of the renegotiations on the ACP/EEC Lome Convention;
- CALLS UPON the OAU Member States, members of the ACP Group, to take necessary measures for the early ratification of the new Lome Convention;

- NOTES with particular interest the decision of the ACP Council of
 Ministers to convene an extra-ordinary session in Kingston, Jamaica, during
 1980 on intra-ACP Co-operation;
- 5. NOTES with satisfaction the establishment of the OAU Office in Brussels and calls upon the Secretary-General to render all possible support to the efforts of the ACP Group.
