

**RESOLUTION ON THE PROGRAMME FOR THE CONTROL OF  
AFRICAN ANIMAL TRYPANOSOMIASIS AND RELATED DEVELOPMENT**

**The Council of Ministers of the Organization of African Unity meeting in its Forty-second Ordinary Session in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia, from 10 to 17 July, 1985,**

**Recognizing the limitation imposed on land use and the development of livestock industry by tsetse and trypanosomiasis in the region,**

**Conscious of the reduced population of livestock in the region as a result of trypanosomiasis,**

**Aware of the famine in several parts of Africa because of drought and tsetse infection among livestock,**

**Recognizing the economic importance of livestock industry in the Member States:**

- 1. MANDATE the OAU Secretary-General to implement this programme;**
- 2. CALLS UPON the OAU Secretary-General to seek funds from external sources – international donors – for the implementation of the programme.**
