# ACHPR/Res. 170 (XLVIII) 10: RESOLUTION TO INCREASE MEMBERS OF THE WORKING GROUP ON OLDER PERSONS AND PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES IN AFRICA 

The African Commission on Human and Peoples' Rights, meeting at its $48^{\text {"t }}$ Ordinary Session in Banjul, The Gambia, from 10 to 24 November, 2010:

Underscoring its mandate to promote human and peoples’ rights and ensure their protection in Africa under the African Charter on Human and Peoples’ Rights (the African Charter);

Recalling the Resolution ACHPR/Res. 106 (XXXXI) 07 of 30 May 2007 on the Rights of Older Persons in Africa, adopted at its 41* Ordinary Session held from 16-30 May 2007, in Accra, Ghana;

Recalling the Resolution ACHPR/Res. 118 (XXXXII) on the Appointment of a Focal Point on the Rights of Older Persons in Africa, that was adopted at its $42^{\text {nod }}$ Ordinary Session held from 15-28 November 2007, in Brazzaville, Republic of Congo;

Recalling further the Resolution ACHPR/Res.143(XXXXV)09 on the Transformation of the Focal Point on the Rights of Older Persons in Africa, into a Working Group on The Rights of Older Persons and People with Disabilities in Africa(the Working Group), adopted at its $45^{\text {" }}$ Ordinary Session held from 13 to 27 May 2009;

Considering the mandate assigned to the Working Group;
Seeking the efficiency required for the Working Group to successfully accomplish the mandate assigned to it;

Recognizing that the success of the Working Group depends on significant support from its members, including their expertise to achieve its specific mandate;

Noting the insufficient number of the members of the Working Group;
Decides to take all the necessary steps to appoint three more members to be part of the Working Group.
